The Derde Wereld Werkplaats (Third World Workshop)

The Derde Wereld Werkplaats (DWW) is a non-governmental organisation NGO that refurbishes second-hand tools and equipment for small projects in developing countries. Our work is financed by foundations, religious congregations, fundraising and individual donations! The Derde Wereld Werkplaats (DWW) supports small scale Vocational Training Centres and small scale initiatives.

Eighty volunteers weekly revise and refurbish quality goods like:

- Hand tools for almost all technical disciplines, like carpentry, mechanical-, electrical engineering, building and auto mechanics.
- Machines, like wood lathe, circular saws, lathe, welding machines IF AVAILABLE.
- Knitting machines (single- and double bed)
- Computers (min. Pentium 4) and HP laserprinters
- Bikes (DWW refurbishes the former public bicycles. These bicycles are uniform, strong, fit for men and women. They have a single gear, a back pedalling brake and 28 inch wheels)
- Sewing machines:
 - o Hand sewing machines, Electrical sewing machines, Treadle sewing machines complete with modern Zig-zag machines, Industrial sewing machines
 - o All machines are delivered with spare parts (needles, oil, bobbins, pressure foots etc.) in a standard wooden box, thus protected during transport.
- The woodwork department makes the wooden crates that are necessary for the transport.

Restrictions of the support

- Only projects that encourage income generating, self sufficiency and/or employment creation can apply for assistance. Individuals are not supported.
- Those who send in an application need to provide sufficient information about their goals, working methods, how many people are involved in the project and benefit direct or indirectly from the support and information about long term planning of the project.
- The DWW only provides equipment **and NO money**.
- We need a recommendation of the Caritas/Church overseer of the district
- A copy of the registration or your project, necessary for clearing purposes to check registered NGO's
- If computers are send we expect that on arrival of the computers a classroom is made ready and that teachers are available to give computerlessons.
- The projects that receive support are obliged to report back to the DWW, when the items that are send are received. Foto's are that support this are very welcome. We on our turn have to inform donors and our volunteers with this information. We also would like to know how the goods help the beneficiaries of your project.

Transport costs

The transport of the equipment to the port of clearing will be catered for.

Please consider that the following costs will be for **the receiver**:

1. The costs of clearing
2. The cost of storage
3. The transport cost from the port of clearing to the project

Before sending in an application it is chief important to make inquiries about local clearing procedures and the possible extra costs you can expect.

Selection

- The DWW will judge the incoming requests on the information that is presented by the projects. The better the information the more chance the project is selected.
- Financial support from donors needs to be found for refurbishing and transport.
- Consider that all tools and machines need to be refurbished. Deliveries will take time but you will be informed about a delivery in advance.
- Reduce your request to the minimum you need. Requests for abundant amount of goods without a detailed request are denied.
