Mr. Fred Obala from International Contact Uganda called me from Kasese, South Western Uganda to tell me about a workshop but I couldn't hear most of what he was saying. His phone seemed to have a Problem. I called him but he always didn't pick my calls, sent him text messages, emails but didn't reply. I visited your Website: [www.dwwbreda.org](http://www.dwwbreda.org) and happened to read about 'SKIT in Uganda' though in Dutch. I looked for UGAPRIV Contacts in Uganda, I got them then they referred us to Mr. Assimwe Edward, the Principal of URDT, the Institute where SKIT is taking Place. He is such a good man.

He told us that we can join if we filled the Application forms and he emailed them to us. We sent our representative Ms. Nakiganda Dorcus. The journey was so horrible that it took her almost 14 Hours to reach Kagadi Town. She travelled by Public means but the Vehicle twice had Mechanical Problems after which it had a flat tyre just 12 kms to the Venue. She almost cried. Other Passengers aboard didn't speak her language and she didn't know where she was going and the time was approaching midnight while still stranded in the jungle. Despite the delays The Principal, Mr. Assimwe was still at the Venue to receive her.

On reaching there, she liked the warm reception accorded to her. Everything at the Venue is superb! The food, the accommodation, the Training is first class. She was 4 days behind others but I trust her abilities, being a finalist at the University that she will catch up with the rest of the Trainees. A special Tutor has been assigned to assist her to progress. Yesterday she called me to thank you on her behalf for this Golden chance to improve on her LifeSkills in Sewing Machines.

On behalf of Tweekembe Association Centre for Rural Systems and Development (T.A- CRUSADE), I have the honour to thank DWW for this Special Training Programme. It will be very useful to us to maintain our training equipment. And when she graduates in SKIT, Dorcus as a Trainer of Trainers will train other Institutions in Maintenance of Sewing Machines. Hopefully, this too will bring T.A- CRUSADE a positive reputation throughout Uganda.
